

The updated standard introduces new cycle durability tests as a way of checking product durability.



Adherence date for all new ladders and step ladders to comply to EN 131 standards.



Transition date

for the Ladder Association and reputable suppliers.

- Existing ladders in good condition do not need to be replaced
- Domestic ladder users can purchase any EN 131 product
